VenaFlux Assay Software Installation

System requirements

VenaFlux assay program is an executable program and a set of supporting DLLs under Windows 7/Windows 8/Windows10.

The following system requirements should be respected to ensure that the VenaFlux assay program operates properly:

- PC with an Intel i5 processor or later version
- Windows 7 or later version
- Minimum of 8GB RAM

Installing the VenaFlux program

To install the VenaFlux program, you will need the VenaFlux Installation CD or USB drive with VenaFlux program.

Note: The user must have administrator rights on the computer to proceed with the VenaFlux Assay program installation.

Place the installation CD into the appropriate CD drive or connect the USB drive. Open the drive folder and run VenaFlux.exe installer program, within this folder. Once VenaFlux.exe is started, the following installation panel will appear on the screen:




Figure 1. InstallShield Wizard for VenaFlux assay

To continue, press the 'next' button. Please read the licence agreement and copyright notice carefully. If the terms of this agreement are acceptable, check the 'I accept the terms in the license agreement' check box.

To continue the installation please click the "next" button on the installation panel. To continue the installation, the user must first fill in the customer information and whether all users may use the software before specifying the appropriate drive and the destination folder to install the VenaFlux program. Use the 'browse' button to navigate through your drives and folders. Click the 'next' button once the appropriate directory for the installation is chosen.

The VenaFlux program will show the 'ready to install the application' panel and be ready to start the installation process. Please ensure that all information presented on this panel is correct before proceeding, if not use the 'back' button to return to the previous menus and correct this information. Finally, click the 'next' button to proceed with the installation.




Figure 4. Ready to install the program

The installation process will then copy the required program files in to the directory specified and the system files into the Windows system directories. Once the installation is finished, the following panel will appear on the screen:

Please click the 'finish' button in order to finish the installation. An option to launch the program directly from this menu will be provided, however, it is also possible to launch the program from the VenaFluxAssay.exe, under Programs -> Cellix Ltd. -> VenaFlux assay in the start menu. It is strongly recommended that the computer is restarted before running the program to ensure proper operation of the VenaFlux program.
